Employee Workers' Compensation Information Guide

What Is Workers' Compensation?

Workers' Compensation is a mandatory program under Connecticut law that provides medical coverage and wage replacement for employees who sustain a work-related injury or illness. The program is governed by Chapter 568 of the Connecticut General Statutes. All employees—full-time or part-time—are covered from the first day of employment.

Reporting an Injury & Medical Treatment

- **Immediately report all work-related injuries or illnesses to your supervisor.**
- For life-threatening emergencies, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.
- For non-emergency injuries requiring treatment, visit the designated initial medical provider.
